



## Holy Family Curriculum Update - Spring 2 2022

### 'Heroes and Heroines'

<b>RE</b>	<p><b>Meals</b> The parish family gathers for the Eucharist (Mass), Jesus' special meal. We find strength in gathering for the celebration of the Eucharist and of God's love in our lives.</p> <p><b>Change</b> Lent offers a time to reflect on life and change. This is a time to prepare for Easter. Change is a necessary part of healthy growth.</p>
<b>English</b>	<p><b>'How to Wash a Woolly Mammoth'</b></p> <p><b>-COLD TASK-</b> write a set of instructions about how to brush your teeth.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-Teach the children the story with the actions</li> <li>-Read the story</li> <li>-Unpick the vocabulary and discuss the story</li> <li>-What are their likes, dislikes, patterns and puzzles?</li> <li>-Box the story up.</li> <li>-Plan their own story.</li> <li>-Write their own story up.</li> </ul> <p><b>-HOT TASK-</b> write a set of instructions about how to make toast.</p> <p>Daily group reading in class - individual reading books for home.</p>
<b>Maths</b>	<p>The children will be counting in multiples of 2, 5 and 10. They will be continuing with number and completing multiplication and division work.</p> <p>The children will continue to count to and across 100, forwards and backwards, from any given number. We will be using practical apparatus including multilink, bar modelling, straws and numicon to support their learning.</p>
<b>Science</b>	<p><b>Plants</b></p> <p>We will continue to identify and name a variety of wild and garden plants, including deciduous and evergreen trees. The children will continue to learn about the basic structure of a variety of common flowering plants, including trees through simple investigations. We will observe the structure and function of spring bulbs.</p> <p>We will continue observe the seasonal changes and weather patterns around us as the nights get lighter. We'll discuss how the length of the day varies. We will try to take a seasonal walk to the park to observe spring - looking for signs of new life and hopefully warmer weather!</p>
<b>Topic</b>	<p><b><u>Kitty Wilkinson</u></b></p> <p>Our topic will focus on the work on a local heroine, Kitty Wilkinson. We will look at what she achieved in our locality. Our learning will be supported through the use of artefacts and first-hand recounts from adults. We will have a visitor in to complete a workshop with us.</p>
<b>Art</b>	<p>Our artwork will focus on weaving, initially with papers, but progressing to fabric strips and threads and natural materials. We will learn about the artist William Morris.</p>
<b>Computing</b>	<p><b>App attack / games design</b> - sequencing, directional language and problem solving. Algorithms.</p>
<b>PE</b>	<p>Basketball</p>
<b>PSHE</b>	<p><b><u>Good to be me</u></b></p> <p>Mrs Clein will be working with the children to discuss mental health and emotional well-being - a self-awareness of feelings. Healthy living.</p>
